

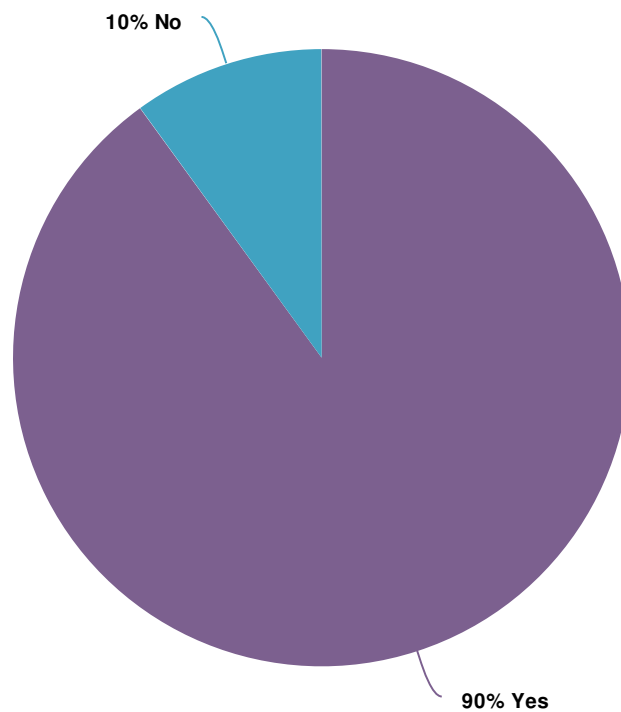

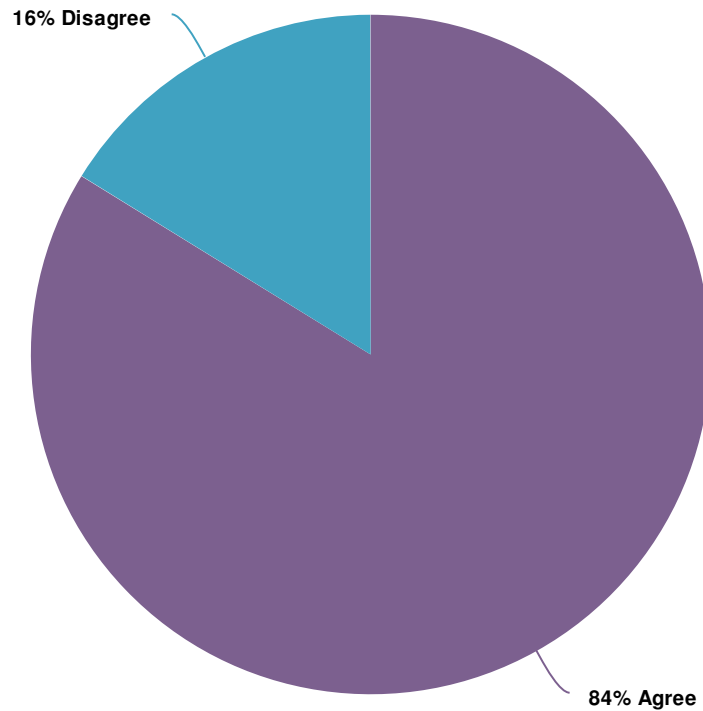
1. Are you experiencing a shortage of hydroxychloroquine and/or chloroquine?

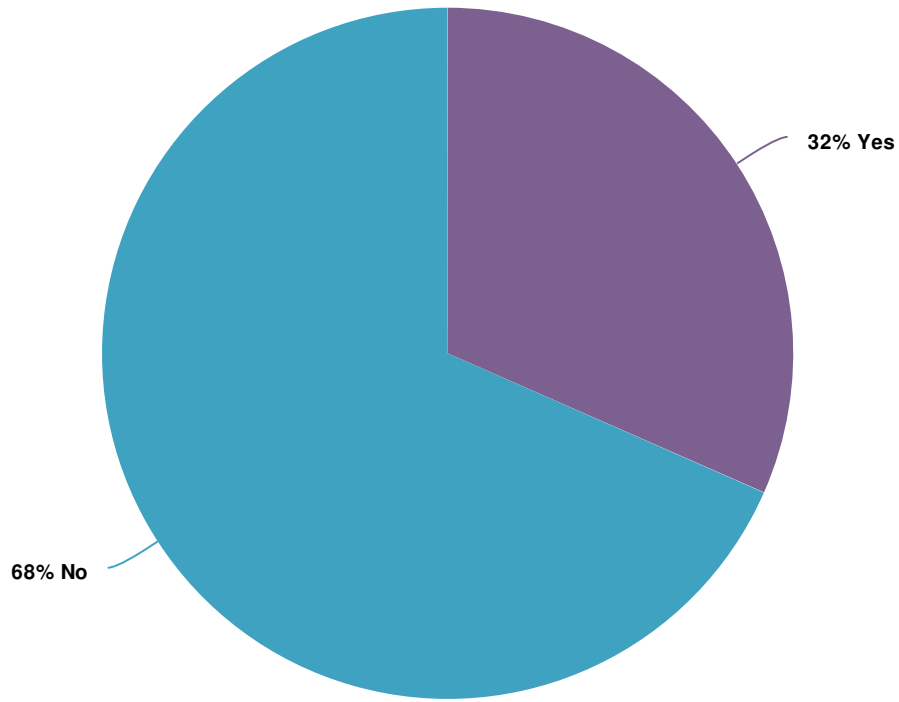

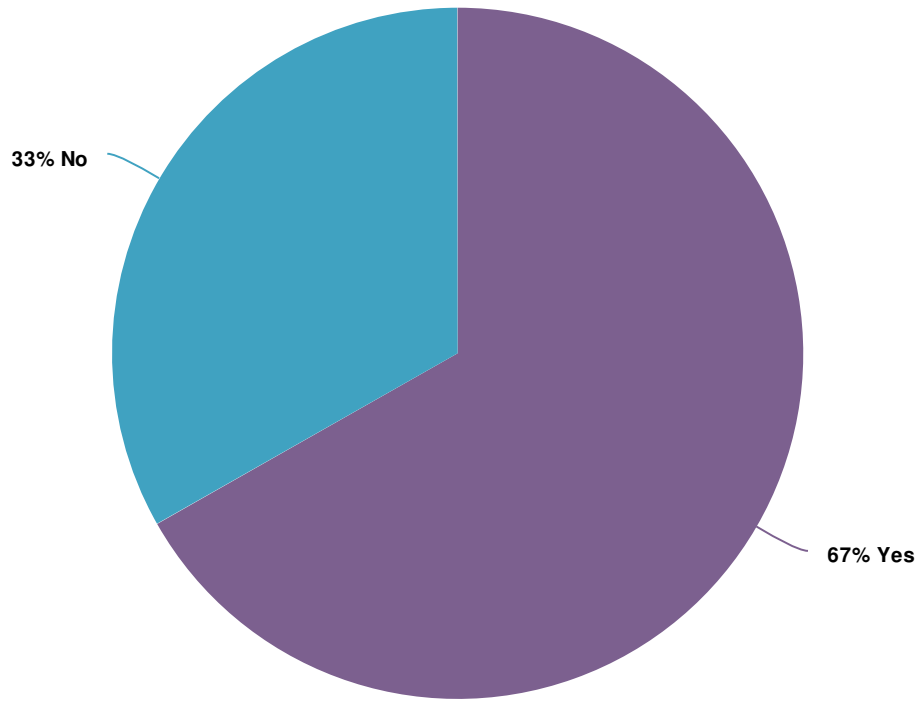
