

## DO YOU PARTICIPATE IN MEDICARE PART D?

### YOU NEED TO KNOW ...

If you're in Medicare Part D, your participation is not always based on the price you pay at the pharmacy counter. Your drug plan may assess retroactive fees to your pharmacy, which effectively lowers that price.

### WHY DOES IT MATTER?

If those fees had been assessed up front, your cost sharing could have been lower and your progression into the "donut hole" could be slowed, maybe even prevented!

**The Department of Health and Human Services is considering a proposal that would account for these fees up front and lower costs for seniors.**

- Pharmacies agree to price concessions with prescription drug plans, yet the plans don't reflect those discounts at point of sale.
- This proposal would require plans to calculate all price concessions from the pharmacy at the time a prescription is filled, slowing progression through the Part D program and potentially reducing cost sharing levels.
- **This proposal could result in net savings for the average senior of over \$200 a year.**
